### This term our reading focus will be:

- Poetry— List poems

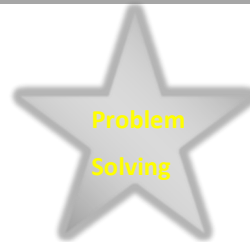


## Numeracy

### This term our numeracy focus will be:

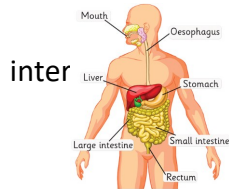
- Decimals
- Measurement: Money
- Measurement: Time
- Statistics
- Geometry: Properties of Shape
- Geometry: Position and Direction

Children will also develop their mental math skills, through the 'Shooting Math's Stars' scheme. Each week children will be tested and move up the different star levels.



### Science 1

Children will create a child-friendly pop-up book using lever and linkages mechanisms based on facts about the Amazon Rainforest.



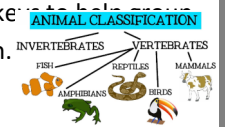
### 2nd- Art
