## Reading

### This term our reading focus will be:

- Non-Fiction—Explanation texts

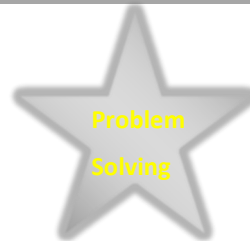


## Numeracy

Children will also develop their mental math skills, through the 'Shooting Math's Stars' scheme. Each week children will be tested and move up the different star levels.




**Our Topic this term is:**

**Invaders**


**Science 1**

Pupils will learn to compare and group materials together on whether they are solid, liquid or gas.




**Science 2**

Pupils will observe that some materials change state when heated or cooled and understand evaporation and condensation in the water cycle.




**RE**

Pupils will focus on Islam and the Easter Story.




**PSHE**

Pupils will focus on the themes Dreams and Goals and Healthy Me.




**Music**

Pupils will develop their skills through learning about Grime, Bhangra and Gospel music,




**4th—DT**

Pupils will design and create their own moving image using a CAM mechanism.




**1st- History**

Pupils will develop historical knowledge and skills related to the topic about Britain's settlements by the Saxons and Vikings.




**ICT**
