

## Stow Heath Primary School—Reception Spring Term Newsletter

## **Reading**

### This term our reading focus will be:

- Blending sounds into words we can read.
- Recognising some digraphs such as sh, ch, th, ng, nk.
- Recognising and reading some common exception words.
- Engaging in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary

Our focus texts in Literacy will be Superworm and Supertato.



## Writing

### This term our writing focus will be:

- Identifying sounds in words and writing them in the correct order.
- Using finger spaces to help write a simple phrase, for example "I am....."
- Using common exception (words we can not break down using phonics) words in our writing. (I, the, to, no, go, she, he, we...)
- Writing out name independently.

## **Numeracy**

#### This term our numeracy focus will be:

- Recognising and representing quantities 0 to 5.
- Ordering objects by mass (heaviest to lightest) and capacity (full to empty).
- Recalling number bonds to 5. (1+4=5, 2+3=5...)
- Naming 3D shapes.

### **Reminders:**

- Reading books to be returned on a Thursday.
- Children to come dressed for PE on a Friday.
- We are outside everyday so children must bring a warm coat to school.
- Name all of your child's belongings.



# How to help your child with their reading at home:

- Read a story to them daily. Discuss the story afterwords—who was in it?, what happened?, if there was a problem how did they solve it?

  What was your child's favourite part of the story? If they could be a character from it who would they be and why?
- Children to read their school reading book once a day to build their fluency when reading.

# How to help your child with their writing at home:

- If your child struggles to hold or use a pencil develop their hand muscles with playdough, threading, cutting activities, tweezers.
- Encourage children to help you write a shopping list.
- Encourage children to write their name where necessary.

## How to help your child with their maths at home:

- Counting songs
- Use vocabulary such as heavy, light, heavier, lighter, full, empty, nearly full when taking part in daily routines.
- Watch episodes of Numberblocks from series 1 and 2.

# Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term we are starting our weekly PSHE lessons where we will be discussing topics such as, what to do when we are faced with a challenge. We continue to support children in developing important social skills, for example, resolving conflicts and expressing their feelings verbally.

### **Physical Development**

Our PE focus this term is 'ball skills'.
Children will be learning how to
control different sized balls through
throwing, catching, pushing and
rolling. Children are encouraged to use
a range of implements including pencils
and scissors to develop their fine-motor
skills.





# Our Topic this term is: Heroes and Villains

### **Understanding the World**

We will be focussing on places and houses where people have lived, beginning with The Celts through to the present day. Children will be discussing what they think it would have been like to live in a Celtic Roundhouse or a Victorian house and think about the similarities and differences to where they live.

# Expressive Arts and Design

This term we are starting our music lessons—children will be learning to clap along to a beat and learning different terms related to music, such as, tempo. In Art we are focussing on junk modelling and connecting materials using different joins and methods to create something new.

### **Communication and language**

To develop children's Communication and Language skills we will have lots of time to discuss and retell stories. Children are encouraged to share their ideas and experiences with adults and their peers. We will be teaching children the skills they require to ask questions which they will be putting into practice when we have our visit from the police!

#### UTW-RE

Children are going to be reading and learning about the Easter story. Children will be given the opportunity to re-tell the story after listening to it.
