Reading and Writing

This term our reading focus will be:

During our time in Rockets class we will be exploring different texts. The children will be sharing stories with adults in the class, and have a very comfy book corner with a sofa where they can share their favourite stories! We will be doing activities linked to our taught stories; We're Going on a Bear Hunt, Hungry Caterpillar and Dear Zoo. The children will have lots of opportunities to share their ideas in writing, retelling of the story and creative activities linked.



Numeracy

This term our numeracy focus will be:

- Joining in with familiar number rhymes
- Number formation
- Subitising numbers up to 5
- Recall number bonds to 10
- Naming 2D shapes
- Sorting objects categorized by colour and size.
