Reading and Writing

This term our reading focus will be:

During our time in Rockets this half term, we will be exploring a variety of texts. We're Going on a Bear Hunt, The Very Hungry Caterpillar and Dear Zoo. The children will have lots of opportunities to explore a vast range of activities that will promote their communication and lanquage development, engage their sensory curiosity and develop their social skills.









Numeracy

This term our numeracy focus will be:

- Joining in with familiar number rhymes
- Completing inset puzzles
- Taking part in finger rhymes with numbers.
- Noticing patterns and arranging objects to create patterns
- Sorting objects categorized by colour and size.
