Year 1 Summer Term 1st Half



Our Topic is called 'Where Shall We Go?'.

In History we will be learning about Columbus, who he is and what he did to become a significant person in our history. In Geography we will be looking at the human and physical features in our local area. Also we will be using maps to locate different features in our local area. In Science we will be carrying out an investigation to see what plants need to survive and grow.

Literacy

In Literacy this half term we will be focusing on spelling our high frequency words and using our phonics to spell new words. We will be writing sentences which include adjectives and conjunctions. We will also try to use capital letters and full stops correctly. The children will also be looking at different genres such as poetry, fantasy stories, traditional and fairy tales.



Numeracy

In Numeracy we will be focusing on mental addition, subtraction, halving and doubling. Children will be using place value to help with this. Also we will be learning to read scales for weight and use money to make different totals.
