## Reading

This term our reading focus will be:

- Recounts / Letters - Christmas
- Traditional Tales - Little Red Riding Hood
- Stories with repeating patterns - The Gingerbread Man
- Instructions - Pancake Day
- Information Texts about floating and sinking, Florence Nightingale and life-cycles.



## Writing

This term our writing focus will be:

- Non-Fiction—Letters
- Fiction—Traditional stories
- Non-Fiction—Instructions
- Fiction—Stories with repeating patterns

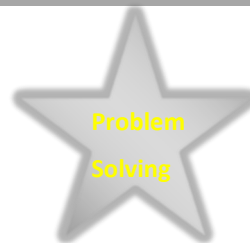


## Numeracy

This term our numeracy focus will be:

- Addition and Subtraction
- Place Value within 50
- Measurement: Length and Weight
- Measurement: Weight and Volume

Children will also develop their mental math skills, through the 'Shooting Math's Stars' scheme. Each week children will be tested and move up the different star levels.



### Science 1

Pupils will learn about materials that will float and sink.



### RE

Pupils will explore religious 'big questions' and learn about the meaning of Easter.



### Music

Pupils will learn about Blues, Folk, Funk and Bossa Nova music.

## To the Rescue & What's around here?

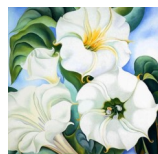
### Geography

Pupils will develop geographical knowledge and skills related to our school's local area by identifying features and creating a 3D and 2D map.
