- Write and spell correctly Year 3 and 4 common exception words.
- Practise given spellings each week.
- Keep a daily diary.

How to help your child with their **maths at home:**

- 15 minutes a day using TimesTable Rockstars.
- Practise using formal method for addition and subtraction.
- Revise 36 multiplication facts.
